What is an Armor-Bearer?

In ancient times, an Armor-Bearer was a soldier who carried a large **shield** for his commander. More than just carrying the shield, **the Armor-Bearer was the shield**, protecting his fighting companion during the attack. Alexander the Great used a great number of armor-bearers who would completely surround him, enabling him to move freely around the battlefield and command his troops to **victory**. In the Bible, David was at one time Saul's armor-bearer (1Sam. 31:4) and Jonathan's armor-bearer was a man of resource and great courage (1 Sam. 14:7). The **dedication and commitment** of these armor-bearers **strengthened the effectiveness** of their leaders and their leader's **ability** to **serve** them.

What is Westminster PCA's Armor-Bearer Ministry?

In a similar way, the Armor-Bearers of Westminster PCA **spiritually rally** around their leaders through **intercessory prayer**. In so doing, they provide a prayer shield of protection from the Enemy while asking for **God's empowerment** to advance His kingdom through the church and their communities.

How can you be an Armor-Bearer?

By God's grace, for **one year**, you will commit to pray daily for your pastors and their families at **every meal** as well as one additional ordained leader **each day**.
