ORIGINAL MEANING: Zechariah 9:1-14:21

"I don't know exactly how, but these things will take place" (similar to Daniel 2,7,9,10-12)

PROMISES ASSOCIATED WITH TEMPLE RECONSTRUCTION – <u>Original Meaning</u>: Zechariah's support of the reconstruction was from God. <u>NT Elaboration</u>: The church must support the continuing reconstruction in Christ. <u>Contemporary Application</u>: We must join the reconstruction program in Christ.

PROMISES OF FUTURE FULL RESTORATION AFTER STRUGGLES – <u>Original Meaning</u>: Zechariah's prophecies for God's people include struggle and eventual victory. <u>NT Elaboration</u>: Confirmed that the church will face struggles but will reach ultimate victory. <u>Contemporary Application</u>: We must hold on through struggles in hope of full restoration in Christ.
